Instructions/ Submission guidelines for the research proposals:

- 1. The Call for Research Proposals is only for **female candidates**.
- 2. The minimum eligibility for applying is **Masters Degree** in any discipline from a recognized university.
- 3. The duration of research is **6** (Six) months from the date of the approval by the scrutiny and selection committee.
- 4. The research proposals approved by the scrutiny and selection committee will get funding of INR **25,000** (Twenty-Five Thousand) all inclusive.
- Research proposals concerning "Women" in the following broad themes are invited. The title of the research proposals should be connected to the thrust areas concerning "Women"
 - a) Higher Education
 - b) Open Distance Learning
 - c) Literature
 - d) Arts
 - e) Culture
 - f) Health
 - g) Gender Studies
 - h) Sustainable Development Goals
 - i) Globalization
 - j) Employment in Organized and Unorganized Sector
 - k) Défense

- l) Entrepreneurship
- m) Government policies
- n) Democracy, Politics and Governance
- o) Other relevant areas/themes
- 6. The following elements are important to include:
 - a) Research topic
 - b) Background and context of the study
 - c) Objective of the proposed study
 - d) Literature review
 - e) Methodology
 - f) Expected outcomes
 - g) Proposed timeline/milestones
 - h) Resources needed and available
 - i) Select bibliography or references (MLA 8th Edition / APA 7th Edition)
- 7. Minimum word limit for the research proposal is 1000 words and maximum 1500 words.
- 8. Authors are requested to follow MLA 8th Edition / APA 7th Edition referencing style.
- 9. Proposals are accepted in English, Gujarati, Hindi and Sanskrit.
- 10. All the proposals will be reviewed by the Scrutiny and Selection committee.
- 11. Decision of the Scrutiny and Selection committee will be final.
- 12. Each research proposal as well as the final research report will be mandatorily put through a plagiarism check on anti-plagiarism software by the University. Any proposal or final report scoring 10 (ten) percent plagiarism count will be disqualified or rejected.
- 13. Research proposals submitted under this scheme to the University should not have been submitted or published elsewhere. Concurrent submissions to other publications or journals is viewed as serious breach and will result into disqualification/rejection.
- 14. The authors are solely responsible for any legal matter resulting out of violation of Copyright act.
- 15. The authors are solely responsible for obtaining copyright and other clearences (if any) prior to submitting the research proposal as well as final report.
